FABRIC RAILROADING This is an important trade term that should be carefully considered by anyone specifying custom upholstery. Generally, upholstery fabrics are 34 to 60 inches wide as they come off the roll. To avoid seams every 34 to 60 inches, the fabric may be rotated 90 degrees (Railroaded) to allow the length of the fabric to be applied to the width of the piece of upholstery. For example, if a sofa is 96" long and has a single seat cushion, by railroading, a seam is avoided in the middle of the seat cushion, front board, and the inside and outside of the back. The pattern and the nature of the fabric will mostly dictate if railroading is applicable.
